Our studio is located in the Sans Souci Literary Institute where we have two halls that have classes catering for ages 18 months and above. Our syllabus has also extended to contemporary and Acrodance exams and our faculty also teach hip hop, lyrical and musical theatre styles within our classes.

Invoicing:

Invoices are issued in week 10 of the previous term, with the exception of Term 1, which is issued 2 weeks prior to the commencement of Term 1.

All term fees are due by the first day of the term and payment plans can be arranged prior to this date if required. Late payment of fees negates your discount scheme, unless payment plan is booked in prior. *For our full fee policy please read below in our policies and procedures.

Discount Scheme:

We offer a discount scheme for students who undertake multiple classes. This is discounted per student, not per family.

3-4 classes per week: 10% discount5 classes per week: 15% discount6 or more classes per week: 20% discount

Discounts are taken off total class fees for that term. Conditions apply for payment on time to receive your discount. Fee discount scheme is not valid for uniforms, shoes or costumes.

Uniform and Shoes:

Our studio uniform can be purchased at the stores listed below. Unfortunately, from 2025 onwards we will not be stocking uniforms on site at the studio. Some items, such as tights and tap shoes will be available to order through our lovely administration manager, however all other uniforms can be purchased through Bloch in Miranda, Daisy Dancewear in Engadine or Beat Street in Carlton. Alternatively, if you prefer to purchase online, we can recommend Dance and Play (online in QLD) or alternatively Energetiks.

Our beautiful friends at Bloch in Miranda have a list of all requirements for our studio should this be a little too overwhelming. They are fabulous at helping you find exactly what you need when you walk in and say "I'm from T K Dance Stars"

We have listed below our uniform including the names of the items relevant to the stores you can purchase these from and the classes they are related to. If you have any questions regarding our uniforms or shoes, please do not hesitate to reach out and we will confirm for you the best uniform choices for your child.

Our Annual End of Year Concert:

Our 2025 end of year concert is a fun and exciting opportunity for your child to perform on stage for their family and friends. It is an inclusive and enjoyable afternoon to showcase your child's talents and the work they have put in throughout the year.

Our concerts are not compulsory, however are encouraged to families to participate in a fun experience. In term 2 we will advise on the formal costs for all costumes and concert package for the event. At this point you can let us know if you would like to participate or just attend normal classes. Once you have committed, the full payment of costumes and packages are required, and a payment plan can be set up for you if required.

This year our concert will be held on Saturday 6th December 2025 for a midafternoon show at the Marana Auditorium in Hurstville.

We have listed below an **estimated** cost breakdown for you to prepare accordingly and for full transparency for the year ahead.

Concert Package: Includes professional video of the show, professional photos from photo day and the concert performance, certificate of participation, USB for all photos and video footage, staff and venue fees for any on stage rehearsal and photo day. (inclusive of gst)

First Child: \$140 Second Child: \$85

Costume costs:

Tiny Dancers and Pre-School costumes: \$40 - \$50 per class All other costumes: \$50 - \$75 per class

Concert Tickets:

Tickets for our show will go on sale on the 1st October 2025. Details for this will be released in Term 2. Tickets range from \$20 - \$40 per ticket for the performance.

Exam Stream:

As a member of the Australasian Dance Association, we host exam sessions with our association for the individual success and achievement of our students.

Exams can be a daunting word for many and can give more stress than needed. Within our studio exams are given a positive and successful individual achievement outlook with many options available for all students to successfully complete exams with support of their teachers and friends.

Our exam stream begins in "Pre-Primary" which is aged between 5-7 years. In Pre-Primary, our students go into their exam in a group of 4 with their teacher and perform their exam exercises with their teacher and friends. This is a nurturing and enjoyable experience for our students to be welcomed into the exam stream at this age.

In Primary and above our students go into their exam in a group of 2-3 friends and perform many exercises together with their friends. As the grades progress, they will perform some exercises and routines on their own.

All students who participate in their exams receive a report exploring their achievements and areas for growth, these are not scored out of 100 but rather are a scale to show the progression level of each exercise individually. Students will also receive a certificate and a badge for their success in passing each level and genre.

Class Performance Awards:

We also have the opportunity for students to undertake a Class Performance Award, or CPA. The CPA is a smaller portion of the exam that the student and teacher can select the students' strongest exercises in the grade to perform if they feel they are not quite ready to undertake the full exam. The student can then take in a buddy and complete all exercises with a buddy. CPA students also receive a report, certificate and a ribbon for their achievement.

Inclusive and Special Education Exams:

The ADA provides opportunities for all students to participate in the success of completing their dance exams. Our Inclusive and Special Education Dance Exams are jointly constructed by the teacher and student to suit the diverse learning needs of the student undertaking the exam. A support person or teacher will enter the exam room with the student and a buddy can accompany them also should this be required to complete the exam. These wonderful students will also receive a report, certificate and ribbon for their successful achievement also.

Diplomas in Dance Teaching:

As our students progress into their higher grades we have the opportunity to offer the Diplomas of Dance Teaching in Tap, Jazz and Classical Ballet with the ADA. These Diplomas range from Pre-Elementary to Advanced and cover our syllabus from our Pre-Primary's through to our Bar to Gold Star Seniors. The Diploma not only encompasses the syllabus content but also covers the anatomy and physiology of the human body, development of our students by age, safe dance practices and various teaching methods and positive classroom management.

ADA Awards Competition:

Within our association we have our annual awards competition. This is a fun onstage performance for students to compete with their exam stream work onstage against many dance schools from within our association. The Awards competition is held from the 28-30th September 2025 and this year will be our Australasian Championships with studios coming from across the South Pacific to compete here in Sydney.

More details regarding this wonderful opportunity will be released in Term 2 when we commence our exam and awards entries.

Policies and Procedures:

Attendance and Respect for Staff and Fellow Students:

- Students are to always respect one another and their teachers
- Attitude or disrespect will not be tolerated. Parents will be notified if a student is showing attitude or disrespect for further communication and discussion.
- Attendance is how we achieve success. If you continually miss classes, we cannot guarantee exams, performance opportunities. If a student is unable to attend a class please contact your teacher **prior** to this class as a courtesy and to discuss available make up lessons.
- Students are to be ready **10 minutes before** their first class is to commence. If a student is not ready to commence their class on time this can disrupt other students in the class and take away from their learning. Please be respectful of other students in your class and arrive in a timely manner.
- Students are **NOT** to leave the premises without a parent / guardian being present to collect them. Parents must enter the hall to collect their child.

Studio Representation:

- Any student representing T K Dance Stars must attend any event in full studio uniform (tracksuit jacket/Studio Polo Shirt)
- All students representing T K Dance Stars must act appropriately, and respect the uniform and studio they are representing at all times.
- T K Dance Stars is a respected family studio with an outlook on positive sportsmanship and encouragement. Students are not to discourage their fellow students and/or other competitors. They are to respect teachers and event staff at all times.

Mobile Phones and Electronic Equipment:

- Mobile phones and Electronic devices must be kept in a student's dance bag at all times when at the studio. They may be retrieved fror videoing purposes and to contact a parent if classes are altered.
- Please note: **T K Dance Stars does not take responsibility for these items whilst on premises.**

Fees:

- All private lessons must be paid for per term as per invoice.
- Fees are to be paid prior to the first day of the specific term to be eligible for the fee discount scheme. Any fees not paid by this date will incur full fee payment not including any discounts.
- Payment plans are eligible to retain discounts if set up prior to the invoice due date at the first day of the term.
- Private lessons **must be paid** for in the event of missed attendance unless the parent informs the studio 1 week prior, AND the lesson has been filled by another student.
- Missed Lessons If your child/ren are unwell or injured we offer a full make up for the value of those classes. This includes any class of the appropriate age group for your child/ren. Due to being a small business we cannot guarantee the "same" class for a make up, however we have a variety of classes in each age group for you to attend as a make up class.
- Any class that is cancelled by a staff member will be made available at another time or day to allow for a make up lesson of this class. This will be advised as soon as staffing and hall arrangements are confirmed to give you as much notice as possible. If you are unable to attend this class then the above missed lessons policy will apply and you will be eligible to attend a make up class of your choice in an eligible age group.
- In the event of a COVID-19 outbreak or pandemic classes will be provided online using either Zoom or Google drive formats. Classes during that remaining term will be non-refundable however the option to re-enrol during a further period will be made available.

Photography and Videography:

- Photography and videography within the studio may only be taken if approval is given by the appropriate member of staff. In the event that this is approved photography/videography may only be used for a families own personal viewing and must be approved by all parents of students within the selected class.
- Under no circumstances are students to use photography and/ or videography within the studio premises unless approved by a teacher.
- Photography and/or videography taken within the studio, must not be uploaded to any form of social media or internet based programs without consent.
- T K Dance Stars is not associated with Tik Tok in any form.

Parents and Guardians:

- T K Dance Stars offers a positive and encouraging environment, where all students are encouraged to perform their best and enjoy the art form of dance. Parents are asked to speak positively and kindly to any student(s) at all times. Derogatory or negative comments toward any student(s), staff or fellow parent(s) will not be tolerated, and if this occurs you may be asked to leave.
- Watching week is the last week of each term. Only on this week will parents be allowed to sit in and watch, but please be advised teachers have the right to change this at any time.
- Watching week for 2-4 years, Pre-Primary and Primary will be split throughout the terms to avoid any major distractions for our young people OR windows will remain open for discrete viewing at any time throughout the term.
- Tiny Dancers may have a parent/guardian viewing during class time due to the young age of these students (18 months -3 years). If you are viewing please ensure any siblings are seated and not disrupting the class during this time.
- Parents must drop off and pick up students at the door of the studio.
- Parents who are waiting in the foyer or kitchen area must respect the classes that are engaged by keeping noise to a minimum and ensuring that any children are kept with their parent at all times.
- Only open the studio doors should you need to enter the class or to use the bathrooms. Additional openings of the door are a large distraction for students and we want to make the most of the time we have with your children to build their success.
- If the hall, kitchen or foyer is vacant, please do not allow children to dance, run around
- in these areas. These are common areas that are used for lunch breaks and seated communal time, not for chasing games or climbing.

WHILST AT THE STUDIO:

- Students who wish to leave the studio to collect food must be accompanied by an adult or WRITTEN consent must be brought to the studio and given to a teacher.
- All students must wear appropriate clothing over their leotard and shorts to walk to and from the studio.
